

Directions to Festival Site at Deutscher Club, Clark, NJ

From the Garden State Parkway heading South:

Take exit 135. At bottom of ramp, turn right onto Central Avenue and go 0.4 miles to first light at Raritan Avenue. Turn left on Raritan and go 0.9 miles to second light at Westfield Avenue (TD Bank on corner). Turn right on Westfield, which changes to Old Raritan Road and then to Featherbed Lane and go 0.5 miles to Deutscher Club on left (787 Featherbed Lane phone 732-574-8600).

From the Garden State Parkway heading North:

Take exit 135. At bottom of ramp, go through first light. Go 100 yards to second light and turn left under Parkway onto Central Avenue. Go 0.4 miles to first light at Raritan Avenue. Turn left on Raritan and go 0.9 miles to second light at Westfield Avenue (TD Bank on corner). Turn right on Westfield, name changes to Old Raritan Road and then to Featherbed Lane and go 0.5 miles to Deutscher Club on left (787 Featherbed phone 732-574-8600).

From the New Jersey Turnpike heading South:

Take exit 14 to route I-78 West, stay in local lanes and take Garden State Parkway South. Follow directions for Garden State Parkway South, above.

From the New Jersey Turnpike heading North:

Take exit 11 to the Garden State Parkway North. Follow directions for Garden State Parkway North, above.

From 287 (in New Jersey) heading North or South:

Take I-78 East to Garden State Parkway South. Follow directions for Garden State Parkway South, above.

NOTE: MOST CONVENIENT AIRPORT IS NEWARK (EWR) WHICH IS 15 MINUTES FROM SITE. LAGUARDIA & JFK ARE 70 MINUTES, ALLOW FOR BAD TRAFFIC.

Bus Information

Bus from New York City Port Authority Bus Terminal: NJ Transit bus 112 Roselle-Clark, Arrive Raritan Road & Featherbed Lane. Walk about 5 to 10 minutes north on Featherbed Lane to party. Last bus back to NYC leaves around 10:15pm.

Train Information

Two nearby NJ Transit stations are Rahway - 3.5 miles and MetroPark (Iselin) - 6 miles. Metropark is also serviced by Amtrak.

The Crowne Plaza, 36 Valley Rd, Clark, NJ. Discounted rates of \$79 for 1 King bed, \$89 for 2 standard beds are available for the nights of Friday, July 23 and Saturday, July 24, but must be booked by July 7. Telephone 732-574-0100 requesting the Danceathon room rate. The hotel is about a 5 minute drive from the event.

Directions from Deutscher Club to Hotel (Crowne Plaza, Clark).

Turn right on Featherbed Lane, go 0.5 miles to light at Raritan Avenue. Turn left at Raritan, go 0.9 miles to light at Central Avenue. Turn right at Central, go through first light, go under Parkway and through second light, bear left at fork signposted to CLARK and follow Valley Road to hotel on left. The **Danceathon** is strictly a not-for-profit party run for the pleasure and benefit of our friends in the dance community. No vendors or commercial sponsors are permitted.

Facility: The Deutscher Club has a stage for the band, a large wood dance floor, tables and chairs, all covered by a 170x60 foot pavilion with roll down plastic sides. And, a large tree-shaded outdoor picnic area with lots of tables. If it rains, **this party doesn't stop!**

We provide: Over eight hours of top class Cajun, Zydeco, and Rockabilly music for your dancing and listening pleasure, picnic tables, snacks, water, soft drinks, burgers and hot dogs at the grill all included with your admission. Beer and wine are available for purchase. *No outside beer, wine or other alcoholic beverages may be brought into the premises.*

You bring: Yourself, some prepared food to feed 4-5 people for the potluck meal (no watermelons please). We have plenty of seating at the picnic tables under the pavilion or outdoors in the biergarten. Feel free to bring a friend or two.

Smoking: The party is smoke free. Smoking is permitted in the parking lot.

Pets: Sorry they are not permitted. Please leave them at home.
